

SNOW EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

- * It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the streets if a snow emergency has been declared, except for physicians on an emergency call or emergency vehicles. When a snow emergency is declared, it will be announced on KLGK.
- * Vehicles must remain off the streets once the snow emergency goes in effect and remain off the streets until the snow emergency is terminated.
- * A vehicle in violation of this Ordinance is subject to a fine of \$25. The fine is payable at the office of the City Clerk at City Hall within 3 business days. If the fine is not paid within the 3 business days, a complaint will be filed as provided by the Code of Iowa.
- * A vehicle in violation of the Ordinance may also be towed to a place as directed by the Chief of Police. The owner of a towed vehicle, in addition to the standard fine, will be required to pay the towing and storage costs.
- * It is unlawful to push or blow snow onto or across public streets or alleys.
- * Snow from sidewalks is to be removed within 24 hours of the end of a snowfall.
